

## Honors 2 Summer Homework

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To practice what you've learned over the past year(s), there is summer homework. You will write 2 essays, **one in the present tense** (NOT present progressive) and **one in the preterite tense** (If you don't know what the preterite/past tense is; it is possible that you have been enrolled in the wrong level Spanish class.) The essays/compositions should be on **2 different topics**. Use a wide variety of vocabulary and grammar concepts. This will be your first grades for Honors 2.

**Follow these rules:**

- Handwritten, NO TYPING
- Skip lines
- No lists (not more than 3 items listed together)
- Write approximately **150 words** for each essay, count them, and write the word count at the top of the first page. Proper names and articles (el, la, un, una) do not count.
- All work must be your own – no relatives, no Internet, no tutors, no siblings. **YOUR OWN WORK!!!** If you need to look up a word, you must use a paper/book Spanish/English dictionary. If you do not have a dictionary, you could use Word Reference, which is an online dictionary. **DO NOT** wait until the week before school starts to do this work. Work on it throughout the summer. In addition to writing these compositions, you may want to practice/study vocabulary and grammar. Our textbook's website is:
